MEXICO MISSION TRIP

Plans are continuing for Tabernacle UMC's Mission Trip back to Mexico next February. The team will be going to work with GYTTE (Give Ye Them To Eat), at the Tree of Life Training Center and Demonstration Farm in Tlancualpican, Mexico. This will be the eighth mission trip to GYTTE from Tabernacle. We have a team of 14 people representing Tabernacle and five other multi-denominational churches in our surrounding area. The team will be doing construction work at the Tree of Life Training Center and in the local community. We will also be immersed in learning how GYTTE works with the rural poor in Mexico to combat hunger and poverty through various developmental programs and opportunities.
